



SURRY COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE MANUFACTURE, HANDLE, SELL EXPLOSIVES PERMIT APPLICATION



This application is required to be completed, signed, and submitted, along with all permit fees, to the Surry County Fire Marshal's Office before any permit may be issued. A copy of all plans, drawings, specifications reviewed, and permit(s) issued by the Fire Marshal are required to be on the worksite or display site at all times. All current and outstanding fees shall be remitted to the Surry County Fire Marshal's Office before any permit is issued or inspection conducted by the Surry County Fire Marshal or his representative.

The Surry County Fire Marshal or his representative may issue a STOP WORK ORDER or ORDER TO REVOKE any permit due to misrepresentation or falsification of the application, misuse, mishandling, unsafe, unforeseen hazards, or events that may arise, failure to comply with applicable provisions of the Fire Code or other reasons set forth by North Carolina State Building Code and North Carolina General Statutes. At the time the STOP WORK ORDER is issued, or the Permit REVOKED, all operations related to such permit(s) shall immediately stop and the worksite or display site and all related materials, equipment and machinery shall immediately be secured and made safe.

The Surry County Fire Marshal requires one (1) complete set of plans, drawings and specifications for each project or permit. Allow a minimum of ten (10) working days for plans review after all required and all requested materials have been submitted to the Fire Marshal' Office. Once submitted, all plans, drawings, specifications, and materials will remain the property of the Surry County Fire Marshal.

After a permit has been issued, no change or deviation from the terms of the permit, application, or submitted plans, drawings and specifications is allowed, until such change or deviation is submitted to the Fire Marshal in writing and approved by the Surry County Fire Marshal or his representative.

Renewal of permits shall be subject to fees in effect at the time of the renewal.

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The applicant or sponsor of the event shall provide the following:

- A corporate bond or valid Certificate of Insurance showing the types and amounts of insurance coverage.
 - The amount of public liability coverage or corporate bond must be an amount deemed to be adequate by the Fire Marshal before a permit will be issued (3301.2.4.1)
- One set of written plans, drawings and specifications showing the property on which the blasting site is located as related to property lines, surrounding structures, roads, overhead and underground utilities, barricades (include height, width, and construction materials) and the location of explosive magazines.
 - Included with the plans must be an inventory listing what types and amounts of explosive materials that are to be used.
- The following policies shall be included with the plans:
 - For storing, handling, and disposing of misfired, damaged, or deteriorated explosives. (3304.10)
 - Maintenance of magazines (3304.8)
 - Disposing of empty packaging materials and containers (3304.7.5.3)
 - Housekeeping in magazines (3304.8.1)
 - Inspection of magazines (3304.9)
- A copy of the US BATF permits to purchase and store explosives
- US DOT Registration of any vehicles used to transport explosives
- Resume' of blaster and person in charge (if different from blaster) of project
 - Include documentation that will establish competences for each
 - If you have not submitted resumes within the previous twelve months, you must submit current ones
